S.H.M.C. Section 20.10.020

(F) "Garage sales" means the sale of personal items owned by the property owner or tenant of the lot on which the sale is being conducted. A maximum of three garage sale events shall be permitted per year. Each event shall not exceed two consecutive days. A permit shall be required for each event, and shall be obtained at the planning department (or via the City's website at www.cityofsignalhill.org).

Permits are required in the City of Signal Hill for garages sales. The City monitors garage sales and may ask to see a copy of the permit during the event. To assist you in having the best garage sale experience, we recommend that you do the following:

- 1. Advise your neighbors that you are planning to have a garage sale.*
- 2. Start and end at reasonable times. Recommended times are from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.*
- 3. Remove ALL signs posted following the event.*

4. *Do not place sale items on the sidewalk, parkway or street; do not sell new items.*
5. *Park your cars elsewhere so that your customers can park in front of your property. Monitor your patrons and discourage them from double-parking or from blocking your neighbor's driveways.*
6. *No loud music.*

For large item pickup such as sofas and refrigerators that didn't sell, please contact EDCO at (562) 597-0608. Large items **MAY NOT BE LEFT ON THE PARKWAY**. You are responsible for assuring that they are picked up and disposed of properly.

Permit must be conspicuously displayed on the premises where the garage sale is conducted, and presented upon request to an enforcement officer.
