

Attention Hilltop Residents Signal Hill 4th of July Hilltop Closure



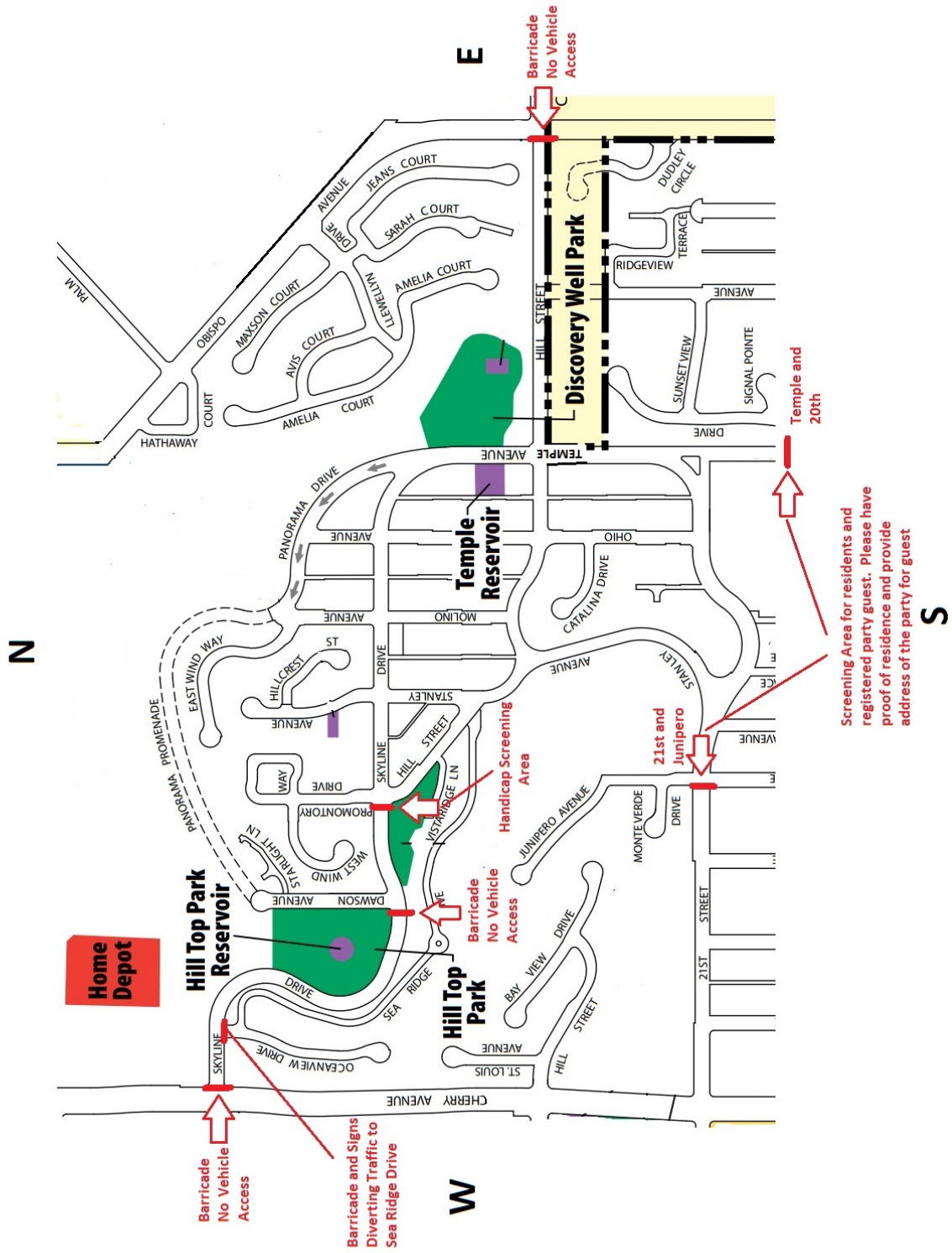
The Signal Hill Police Department would like to inform all residents that the hilltop area will be closed to all non-residential vehicular traffic on the 4th of July holiday beginning at 6pm. The Signal Hill Police Department suggests that all individuals and families interested in viewing the aerial firework displays can enjoy the view from the hilltop, but should consider attending the shows at The Queen Mary, The Armed Forces Reserve Center in Los Alamitos, or other shows in the Long Beach area because hilltop space is limited.

The Signal Hill Police Department would like to remind everyone that the possession, sale, and discharge of all types of fireworks, including “Safe and Sane” fireworks are prohibited within the City of Signal Hill, and will be enforced. The Signal Hill Police Department is committed to providing a safe environment for residents and visitors on July 4th.
