DISCUSSION ITEM(S)

(A) LET'S MOVE CITY PROGRAM

Community Services Director Alcivar-McCoy presented an update to Commission a summary of the work of the Let's Move Committee, including new information on the City website about local Farmers' Markets and helping families make healthy choices; potential involvement of the Fresh and Easy market in local events; working with the schools to create activity based programs; and distribution of trail maps.

The Commission had several suggestions: a downloadable trail map and location of Farmers' Markets to be placed on the website; health fairs held in the past by the Chamber seem more successful if linked to another event; a "City evening walk"; potential tie-in to Sierra Club existing hikes; and other adult health programs.

Community Services Director Alcivar-McCoy presented an update on various presentations, programs and events including changes to the fee schedule submitted to Finance; a copy of the City Council/ Redevelopment Agency report approved on March 22, 2011 authorizing the sale of bonds for design and construction of a new Signal Hill Library; and an update on staff efforts with Signal Hill Petroleum to find a suitable location to construct a Dog Park.

There was no public business from the floor.


ADJOURNMENT
