Summary:

Staff received a request from Alvarado Elementary School for a facility fee waiver in the amount of \$390.00 for the use of the Signal Hill Park Open Space and Picnic Shelter #3 for their 5th grade picnic celebration on Tuesday, June 11, 2024.

Strategic Plan Goal(s):

Recommendation:

Review and consider waiving facility fees for use of Signal Hill Park Open Space and Picnic Shelter #3 on Tuesday, June 11, 2024.

Fiscal Impact:

The total fee waiver request is \$390.00 for the use of all requested facilities and open space.

- b. FEE WAIVER REQUEST FOR THE LONG BEACH MINERAL AND GEM SOCIETY GEMS ON THE HILL EVENT

Summary:

The Parks and Recreation Commission will consider a waiver request from the Long Beach Mineral and Gem Society (LBMGS), a local non-profit, for facility fees for its annual Gems on the Hill event, to be held at the Signal Hill Public Library on Saturday, October 12 and Sunday, October 13, 2024. The LBMGS is requesting a waiver of rental fees for the use of the Signal Point Terrace, Zinnia Courtyard, Children's Area, and the Community Room. The City's adopted policy states that non-profit agencies meeting specific criteria are eligible for a fee

waiver consideration.

Strategic Plan Goal(s):

Recommendation:

Staff recommend the Parks and Recreation Commission approve the LBMGS fee waiver request for the following:

1. A waiver of fees for the use of the Signal Point Terrace; Zinnia Courtyard; Children's Area; and the Community Room, on Saturday, October 12, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. and Sunday, October 13, 2024 from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and,
2. Display a banner on the exterior of the Library and at Cherry and Hill Street in advance of the event.

Fiscal Impact:

The cost of the facility use fees is estimated to be \$7,877.50.
