A Regular Meeting of the Signal Hill Parks and Recreation Commission was held in the Council Chambers of City Hall on October 12, 2011.

CALL TO ORDER

Commissioner Cunningham called the meeting to order for the Parks and Recreation Commission at 6:04 p.m.

DISCUSSION ITEM(S)

(A) RAYMOND ARBOR PLAY EQUIPMENT

Staff presented options for replacement of a piece of play equipment at Raymond Arbor Park.

Staff was directed to return to the Commission at the November meeting with additional options and color schemes for climber type equipment.

(B) STATISTICAL REVIEW FISCAL YEARS 2009/2010 AND 2010/2011

Staff provided an overview of the fiscal years 2009/2010 and 2010/2011 usage and attendance for programs, services and activities provided by the Community Services Department.

Staff was directed to provide an update when reviewing the mid-year budget to show trends for 6 months of fiscal 2011/12, and to look into potential shopping bargains for grocery items for the Brown Bag program.

(C) HISTORICAL SOCIETY FEE WAIVER REQUEST

The Commission considered a fee waiver request from the Signal Hill Historical Society for use of the Signal Hill Park Community Center on Friday, December 16, 2011, excluding the staff cost.

It was moved by Vice Chair Dudley and seconded by Commissioner Damrow to approve the Signal Hill Historical Society's request for a waiver of fees.

(D) UPDATES ON CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS, PARK PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS

Each month staff will provide an update on various actions, which affect the Community Services Department such as City Council direction, project status for park development, or other Community Services programs which have changed over the previous month.

Community Services Director Alcivar-McCoy highlighted the 9/11 Memorial Ceremony and the library programs. It was moved by Commissioner Cunningham and seconded by Vice Chair Davis to receive and file this report.

(E) REVIEW OF COMMISSION REVOLVING OBJECTIVES

Each month staff and Commissioners will provide an update on various actions taken regarding items identified on the Commission Revolving objectives.

The only current item is the Dog Park project. A meeting will be set up to review options, which will be reviewed at the Commission meeting in November. It was moved by Vice Chair Dudley and seconded by Commissioner Lopez to receive and file this report.


ADJOURNMENT
