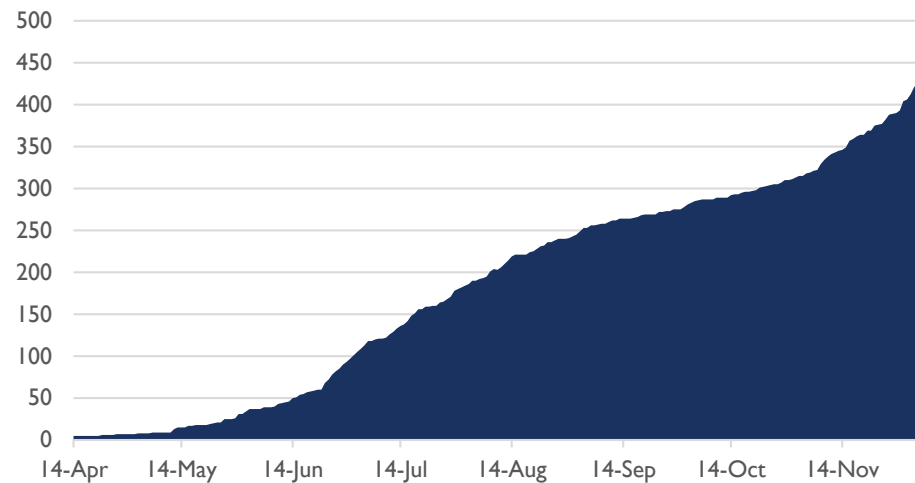

FOR RESIDENTS – REGIONAL STAY AT HOME ORDER

- Issued by the California Department of Public Health on December 3, 2020
 - In response to rise in cases, hospitalizations, and test positive rates
 - All gatherings with members of other households are prohibited
 - Individuals shall stay at their place of residence
 - Worship and political expressions are permitted outdoors
 - Critical infrastructure sectors may operate with required modifications
 - Guidance related to schools remain in effect and unchanged
 - Retailers may operate indoors at no more than 20% capacity
 - The sale of food, beverages, and alcohol for in-store consumption is prohibited
 - Outdoor recreation facilities may continue to operate
 - Order remains in place for at least 3 weeks

FOR RESIDENTS – LACDPH HEALTH OFFICER ORDER

- Issued on December 5, 2020 and effective December 6, 2020 for at least 3 weeks
 - CLOSED SECTORS
 - Indoor and outdoor playgrounds
 - Indoor recreational facilities
 - Hair salons and barbershops
 - Personal care services
 - Museums, zoos, and aquariums
 - Movie theaters
 - Family entertainment centers
 - Cardrooms and satellite wagering
 - Live audience sports
 - Amusement parks

FOR RESIDENTS – LACDPH HEALTH OFFICER ORDER

- Issued on December 5, 2020 and effective December 6, 2020 for at least 3 weeks
 - MODIFIED SECTORS
 - Outdoor recreational facilities – No food, drink, or alcohol sales. No overnight stays at campgrounds.
 - Retail – Indoor operation at 20% capacity. No eating or drinking in stores.
 - Hotels and lodging – Open for critical infrastructure support only.
 - Restaurants – Open for take-out, pick-up, or delivery only.
 - Wineries, breweries, distilleries – Retail only.
 - Critical infrastructure, non-urgent medical and dental, and childcare – must observe 100% masking and physical distancing

FOR RESIDENTS – CA NOTIFY

- California is offering a new exposure notification program
 - Opt-in program available for smartphones beginning this Thursday
 - For Android users, download an app
 - For iPhone users, turn on “exposure notifications” under Settings
 - Smartphones will exchange Bluetooth “keys” with other enabled phones when you spend a specific amount of time near them. If they later test positive you get notified or vice versa. No personal identifying information or location information is collected.

FOR RESIDENTS – TRAVEL ADVISORY

- California Department of Public Health has provided the following guidelines for travel
 - For Non-Essential travel (tourism or recreational in nature)
 - Persons arriving in CA from other states or countries, including returning CA residents, should self-quarantine for 14 days after arrival

SMALL BUSINESS RESOURCES – CALIFORNIA REBUILDING FUND

- The California Rebuilding Fund will support small businesses by offering flexible, affordable capital and free advisory services through community-based lenders
 - Recommended by the Governor’s Task Force on Businesses and Jobs Recovery
 - Public-private partnership
 - Lenders will offer a standardized loan product up to \$100,000
 - Funds will be distributed equitably across the state
 - California Small Enterprise Task Force will lead the implementation of the Fund

SMALL BUSINESS RESOURCES – TAX RELIEF

- California has announced temporary tax relief for eligible businesses impacted by COVID-19 restrictions
 - Automatic 3-month income tax extension for taxpayers filing less than \$1 million in sales tax
 - Extends the availability of existing interest and penalty-free payment agreements to businesses with up to \$5 million in taxable sales
 - Provides expanded interest-free payment options for larger businesses

SMALL BUSINESS RESOURCES – SMALL BUSINESS HIRING TAX CREDIT PROGRAM

- Eligible small businesses can receive up to \$100,000 in tax credits if they meet the following qualifications
 - Employed 100 or fewer employees as of December 31, 2019.
 - Suffered a 50% decrease or more in income tax gross receipts when comparing the second quarter of 2020 to the second quarter of 2019.
- Tentative credit reservations are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis

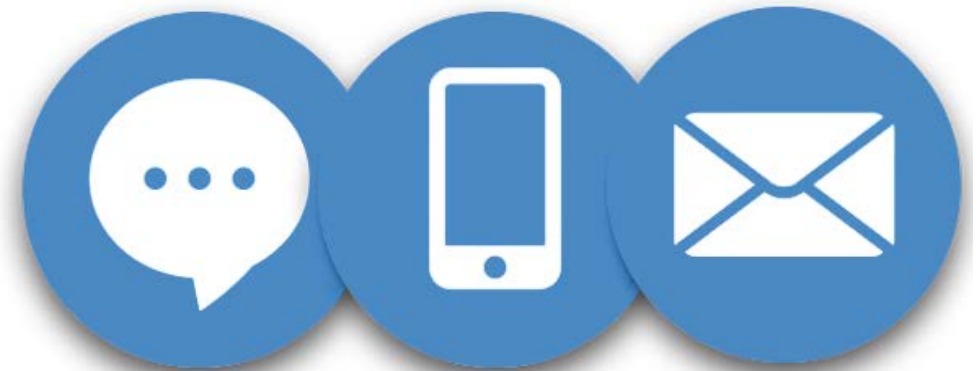
