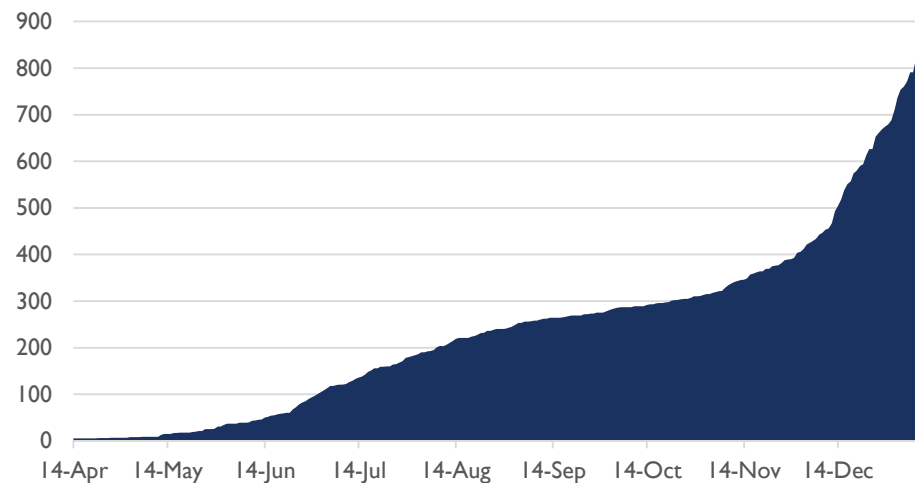

FOR RESIDENTS – REVISED TEMPORARY TARGETED SAFER AT HOME HEALTH OFFICER ORDER (DECEMBER 30, 2020)

- Issued by LACDPH and in effect for as long as the State Public Health Officer’s Regional Stay At Home Order remains in effect
 - In response to rise in cases, hospitalizations, and test positive rates
 - Individuals shall stay at their place of residence
 - Individuals shall practice physical distancing and using face coverings
 - All gatherings with members of other households are prohibited
 - Critical infrastructure sectors may operate with required modifications
 - Retailers may operate with reduced capacity
 - Restaurants and other food facilities are open only for delivery, drive thru, and carry out

 - Both the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines have been shown to be safe and very effective in large studies that involved a diverse mix of people.
 - These vaccines prevented 95% of cases of Covid-19.
 - While the vaccine stops people from getting sick, it is not yet clear if it stops them from spreading Covid-19 to others. It is also not yet known how long they will be immune. That is why we must still wear face coverings, practice physical distancing, and not gather.

Phase 1A

About 3 million people

- Healthcare workers
- Long-term care residents

Phase 1B

1B Tier One:

- Individuals 75 and older
- Those at risk of exposure at work in the following sectors:
 - Education
 - Childcare
 - Emergency services
 - Food and agriculture

1B Tier Two:

- Individuals 65 -74

Phase 1C

- Individuals 50 -64 years of age
- People 16-49 years of age and have an underlying health condition or disability which increases their risk of severe COVID-19
- Those at risk of exposure at work in the following sectors:
 - Water and wastewater

FOR RESIDENTS – VACCINATION INFORMATION (FAQS)

- Can you get Covid-19 from a vaccine?
 - No. Covid-19 vaccines being developed in the US do not contain the virus that causes Covid-19.
- How many shots of Covid-19 vaccine will I need?
 - Most of the vaccines are given in two doses a few weeks apart. It is important to get the same kind of vaccine for both shots.
- If I already had Covid-19, do I still need to get vaccinated?
 - Yes. We don't yet know how long you are protected after you have had Covid-19, so it is important to have the vaccine to strengthen your immunity.
- Will I have to pay to get a Covid-19 vaccine?
 - No. Your doctor or pharmacy may charge a fee, but it should be covered by public and private insurance companies. There should be no out-of-pocket payments.

FOR RESIDENTS – VACCINATION INFORMATION (MYTHS)

- Myth: The vaccines can make you sick with Covid-19.
 - Fact: The current vaccines don't include the virus in any form. You cannot get the disease from the vaccine.
- Myth: These vaccines use genetic material to fight the virus. That means they can affect our genes.
 - Fact: These vaccines do use genetic material to fight the virus but it doesn't do anything to your genes. You encounter genetic material from other plants and animals all the time when you eat them.
- Myth: The vaccine contains a micro chip that can be used to track my movements.
 - Fact: The vaccine does not contain any kind of track device.
- Myth: Don't these vaccines contain dangerous chemicals that can have serious health effects?
 - Fact: These vaccines have been carefully tested for safety.

FOR RESIDENTS – VACCINATION INFORMATION (SCAMS)

- Scam: Someone offers to move you into an earlier group for a fee.
- Scam: Someone tries to sell you a place on a Covid vaccine waiting list. There is no waiting list.
- Scam: Someone on the street, online, on social media, or knocking on your door tries to sell you a shot of vaccine.
- Scam: You see ads for fake vaccines or “miracle cures” using vitamins or other dietary supplements.

FOR RESIDENTS – CA NOTIFY

- California is offering a new exposure notification program
 - Opt-in program available for smartphones beginning this Thursday
 - For Android users, download an app
 - For iPhone users, turn on “exposure notifications” under Settings
 - Smartphones will exchange Bluetooth “keys” with other enabled phones when you spend a specific amount of time near them. If they later test positive you get notified or vice versa. No personal identifying information or location information is collected.

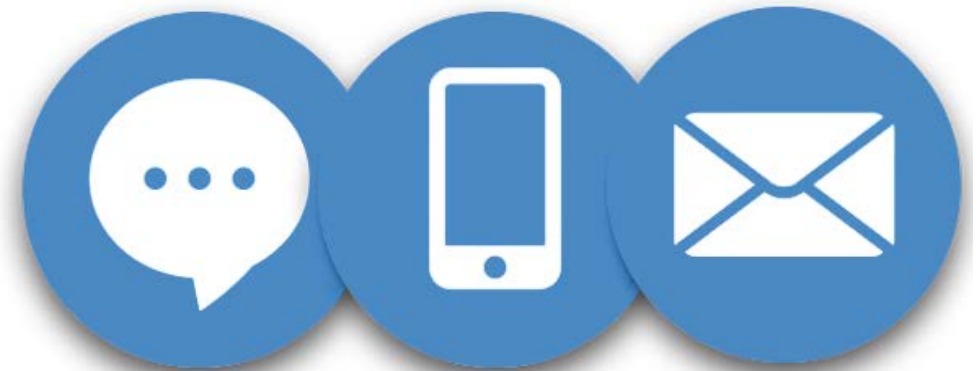
