# EVERYONE IS SUSCEPTIBLE TO COVID-19

## Update for March 9, 2021

As of March 9, California has 3,507,266 confirmed cases of COVID-19, resulting in 54,395 deaths. The number of COVID-related deaths increased by 0.3 percent from the prior day total of 54,224.

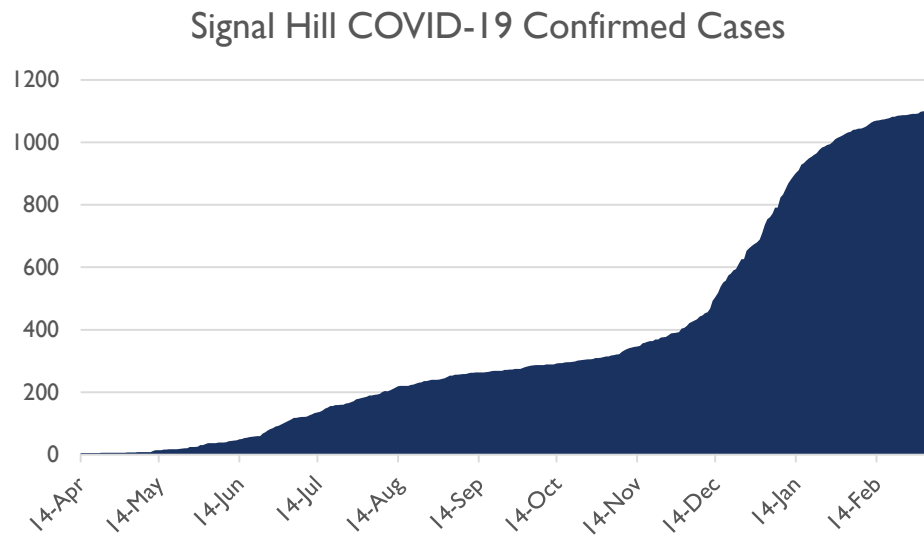

# BLUEPRINT FOR A SAFER ECONOMY

Every county in California is assigned to a COVID-19 risk-level tier based on:

- ▶ **New cases:** The average number of new cases per day, over 7 days, per 100,000 residents
- ▶ **Positive tests:** The percentage of coronavirus tests given per day that are positive for COVID-19
- ▶ **Health Equity:** Although the Health Equity metric does not move a county to a more restrictive tier, meeting specified thresholds for a less restrictive tier can allow a county to progress to a less restrictive tier. Check out the thresholds for [progressing to a less restrictive tier via the Health Equity metric](#).

Tier Level	New Cases per 100,000*	Positive Tests
<b>Widespread</b> PURPLE	 More than 7	More than 8% testing positivity rate
<b>Substantial</b> RED	 4 to 7	5 - 8%
<b>Moderate</b> ORANGE	 1 to 3.9	2 - 4.9%
<b>Minimal</b> YELLOW	Less than 1	Less than 2%

\* Case numbers are adjusted up or down based on testing volume above or below the state median.

Red Tier	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Capacity limited to 20%</li><li>• Concessions allowed while seated</li><li>• In-state visitors only</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Capacity limited to 15%</li><li>• In-state visitors only</li></ul>
Orange Tier	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Capacity limited to 33%</li><li>• In-state visitors only</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Capacity limited to 25%</li><li>• In-state visitors only</li></ul>
Yellow Tier	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Capacity limited to 67%</li><li>• In state visitors only</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Capacity limited to 35%</li><li>• In-state visitors only</li></ul>

# VACCINATION INFORMATION

## CURRENT ELIGIBILITY (MARCH 1)

- Approximately 3.4 million people are now eligible in LA County
  - Healthcare Workers
  - Staff and Residents at Skilled Nursing Facilities
  - Staff and Residents at Long-Term Care Facilities
  - Residents 65 and Older
  - Education and Childcare Workers
  - Emergency Services Workers
  - Food and Agriculture Workers

# VACCINATION INFORMATION UPCOMING ELIGIBILITY (MARCH 15)

- Vaccination eligibility will open to residents between 16 and 64 years old who have certain disabilities or severe underlying medical conditions

**COVID-19 vaccination: Find out if it's your turn**

Everyone in California will have an opportunity to get vaccinated against COVID-19 at no cost. But our vaccination supply is limited right now. So we're starting with the groups who are at highest risk, like people with a high chance of exposure and people 65 and older.

#### Are you eligible?

Find out if it's your turn by answering a few questions. It only takes a few minutes. If you're eligible and vaccine appointments are available through My Turn, you can schedule one. If it's not your turn yet or appointments are not available, you can register to be notified when you're eligible or when appointments open up.

If you're near San Francisco, Los Angeles, or San Diego, you may be able to schedule your appointment today. We are adding appointments to My Turn daily, and expanding statewide.

# HAVE YOU BEEN FULLY VACCINATED?

## Have You Been Fully Vaccinated?

People are considered fully vaccinated:

- 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, like the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or
- 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, like Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine

If it has been less than 2 weeks since your shot, or if you still need to get your second dose, you are NOT fully protected. Keep taking all [prevention steps](#) until you are fully vaccinated.

# WHEN YOU'VE BEEN FULLY VACCINATED (CDC) WHAT HAS CHANGED

- You can gather indoors with fully vaccinated people without wearing a mask
- You can gather indoors with unvaccinated people from one other household (for example, visiting with relatives who all live together) without masks, unless any of those people or anyone they live with has an increased risk for severe illness from COVID-19
- If you've been around someone who has COVID-19, you do not need to stay away from others or get tested unless you have symptoms
- LACDPH is reviewing the guidance and will be updating its guidance

# WHEN YOU'VE BEEN FULLY VACCINATED (CDC) WHAT HASN'T CHANGED

- Keep taking precautions in public places
  - Wear a mask
  - Stay 6 feet apart from others
  - Avoid crowds and poorly ventilated spaces
- Avoid medium or large size gatherings
- Delay domestic and international travel
- Still watch out for symptoms of COVID-19
- Get tested for COVID-19 if you are symptomatic

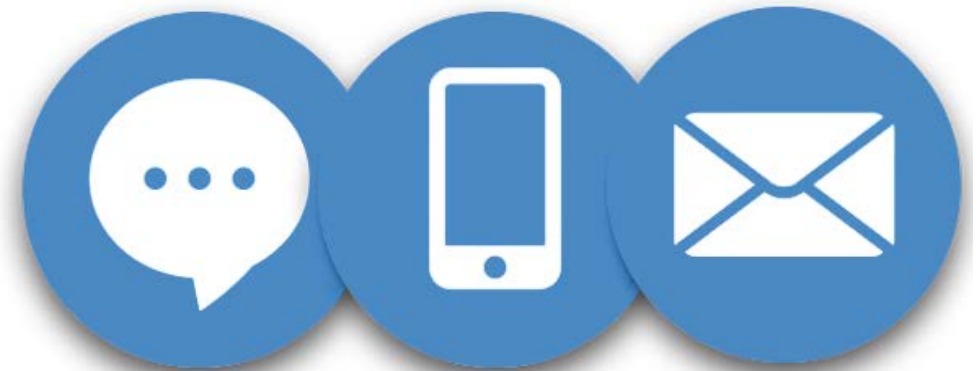
