## Update for March 23, 2021

As of March 23, California has 3,549,101 confirmed cases of COVID-19, resulting in 56,596 deaths.

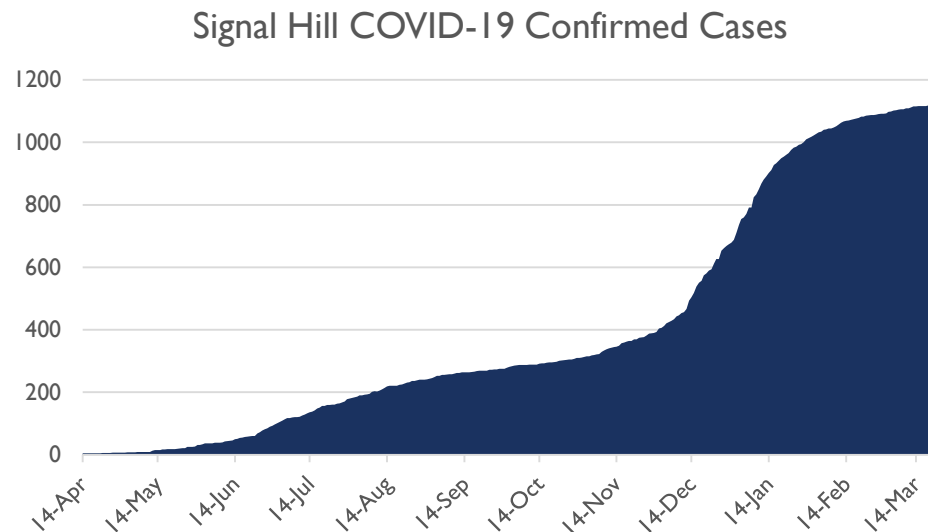

## Updates to the State's Blueprint for a Safer Economy

Doses administered in the Vaccine Equity Quartile (statewide)	Tier 1 Widespread (Purple)	Tier 2 Substantial (Red)	Tier 3 Moderate (Orange)	Tier 4 Minimal (Yellow)
Current: Less than 2 million doses administered	Case Rate > 7	Case Rate 4 - 7	Case Rate 1 - 3.9	Case Rate < 1
Goal #1: 2 Million administered	Case Rate > 10	Case Rate 4 - 10	Case Rate 1 - 3.9	Case Rate < 1
Goal #2: 4 Million doses administered	Case Rate > 10	Case Rate 6 - 10	Case Rate 2 - 5.9	Case Rate < 2

# REOPENING INFORMATION

## RESTAURANTS

### Indoor dining with modifications:

- Max 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is fewer
- 8 feet distancing between tables  
One household per table with limit of 6 people

### Outdoor dining with modifications:

- Expand from one household up to six per table to members from 3 households (up to six people) per table

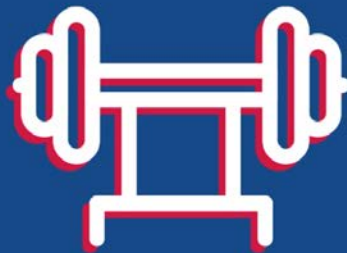

# REOPENING INFORMATION

## **GYMS, FITNESS CENTERS AND YOGA STUDIOS**

- Indoor operations allowed at 10% capacity
- Climbing walls open
- Gyms can offer personal training
- Masking always required

## **PRIVATE GATHERINGS**

**Allowed outdoors and indoors with modifications:**

- Masks and physical distancing required
- No more than 3 separate households attend

## CURRENT ELIGIBILITY

- Education and Childcare Workers
- Emergency Services Workers and Law Enforcement
- Food and Agriculture Workers
- Healthcare Workers
- Janitorial, Custodial, and Maintenance Services Workers
- People who live or work in high risk congregate living spaces
- People with serious health conditions or disabilities
- Residents 65 and Older
- Staff and Residents at Skilled Nursing Facilities
- Staff and Residents at Long-Term Care Facilities
- Transportation and Logistics Workers

**COVID-19 vaccination: Find out if it's your turn**

Everyone in California will have an opportunity to get vaccinated against COVID-19 at no cost. But our vaccination supply is limited right now. So we're starting with the groups who are at highest risk, like people with a high chance of exposure and people 65 and older.

#### Are you eligible?

Find out if it's your turn by answering a few questions. It only takes a few minutes. If you're eligible and vaccine appointments are available through My Turn, you can schedule one. If it's not your turn yet or appointments are not available, you can register to be notified when you're eligible or when appointments open up.

If you're near San Francisco, Los Angeles, or San Diego, you may be able to schedule your appointment today. We are adding appointments to My Turn daily, and expanding statewide.

Arrive at your registered appointment time, stay in your car, and follow the posted signs. Our clinical team will walk you through collecting your own sample.

24 - 48 hrs

Your results will be sent to you on a secure, HIPAA compliant system, by your selected preference – text or email.

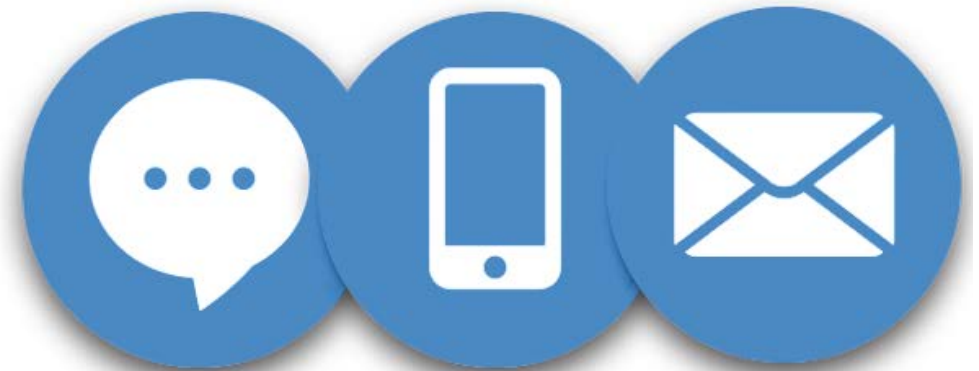
