

Traffic Control General Notes:

- All traffic control devices shall conform to the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (CA-MUTCD) 2014 edition and the Caltrans Standard Specifications latest edition.
- The City Traffic Engineer division reserves the right to observe the traffic control operations and to make any necessary changes. Any directed changes shall supersede these plans and shall be implemented at the sole expense of the contractor.
- All traffic control devices shall be kept in their proper position at all times and shall be repaired, replaced, or cleaned as necessary to preserve their appearance and continuity.
- All delineators shall be equipped with reflective band at nighttime. All warning signs shall be equipped with reflective band at nighttime.
- Contractor shall cover or remove all conflicting signs and markings
- Contractor to provide access to driveways at all times.
- Contractor shall maintain safe pedestrian access at all times.
- Contractor shall provide flagman as necessary to give adequate warning to traffic or to the public of any dangerous conditions to be encountered.
- When work is suspended at the end of the working hours, temporary traffic control devices that are no longer appropriate shall be removed or covered.
- Contractor shall provide access to safe two-way traffic movement during non-working hours.
