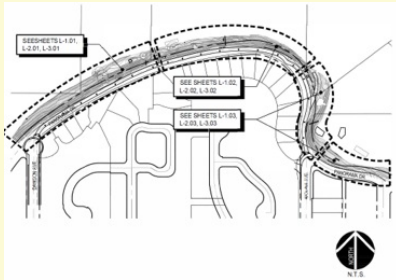
### Mayor's Message March Updates in Signal Hill
