Food Distribution Program Application

The Food Distribution Program provides meat, poultry, fish, fruits, vegetables, dry goods, and canned groceries on a bi-weekly basis to senior citizens who are 55 years of age and older. Seniors must reside in Signal Hill and meet the program's income criteria. Please complete the information below and the attached Public Service Self-Certification Form in its entirety. Once completed please submit it to the Signal Hill Community Services Department, 2175 Cherry Avenue, Signal Hill 90755.

Program Guidelines:

- Extremely low and low income Signal Hill residents are eligible for the program, others will be considered as funding is available.
Participant's income is determined by the sum of all adults with income in the household.
If participant is not available during regularly scheduled pick-up time, an alternate time may be arranged by calling (562)989-7330 the day before distribution day.
Participants will not receive a bag after pickup time if a call is not made the day prior.
Participant will be removed from the program if he/she misses 3 distributions in a row. Once removed participants may reapply for the following Fiscal Year which begins July 1 or he/she will be placed on the waitlist.
A waitlist will be established once the program is filled to its maximum capacity.
Participant may be asked to resubmit documents during the program year to verify continued eligibility.
Each participant is assigned two reusable bags with their program number that must be returned for reuse each distribution time.

Applicants must provide current copies of the following information with this application:

- Proof of Signal Hill residency (Current Utility Bill)
- Income certification
- Verification of age
- Photo ID
